THIS MATTER having been brought by the Court on application of

Daniel Francisco for a concealed carry permit, to wit

and Assistant Monmouth County

Prosecutor, Tara Wilson, Esq., appearing on behalf of the State of New Jersey; and Edward Paltzik, Esq., appearing on behalf of the Applicant;

Whereas the Court having found that the Applicant satisfied the requirements of N.J.S.A. 2C:58-4 by completing the application, providing three references, undergoing an investigation and being granted approval by the Englishtown Chief of Police, and demonstrating his familiarity with the safe handling of the handgun through the R.O.C. and National Rifle Association classroom and range course training/qualification;

IT IS ON THIS 25th day of August, 2022,

ORDERED that the application for permission to carry said handgun referenced above, be and hereby is approved by permitting

the said applicant to carry said weapon(s) subject to the "sensitive places" set forth below and more fully outlined in this Court's oral decision, at which the carry permit shall be deemed invalid, including;

- 1. Schools/Educational Institutions;
- 2. Government buildings;
- 3. Legislative assemblies;
- 4. Polling places;
- 5. Courthouses;
- 6. Shopping malls (if restricted by the private entity;
- 7. Private property/businesses (if restricted by the private entity;
- 8. Bars and nightclubs;
- 9. Any location where alcohol is served or any facility with a license for on-premises cannabis consumption.
- 10. Any place or time that a permit holder is ingesting any intoxicating substance regardless of whether the permit holder is actually intoxicated, impaired, or under the influence;
- 11. Also, while any permit holder who is operating or riding in a motor vehicle the handgun must be stored in the trunk and unloaded pursuant to N.J.S.A. 2C:39-6(g);

12. Any place where carrying a firearm is prohibited by federal, state or local law; and it is further

ORDERED, that the Applicant shall carry this permit at all times that he is carrying the handgun for which this approval has been granted; it is further

ORDERED, that pursuant to N.J.S.A. 2C:58-4(f), if the Applicant becomes subject to any of the disabilities set forth in N.J.S.A. 2C:58-3(c), this permit shall be void and the Applicant shall immediately surrender the permit to the superintendent who shall give notice to the licensing authority; it is further

ORDERED, that in accordance with the requirements set forth in N.J.S.A. 2C:39-6, the Applicant shall annually qualify in the use of the handgun; it is further

ORDERED, that the Applicant shall renew the carry permit every two years, pursuant to N.J.S.A. 2C:58-4(a); it is further

ORDERED, that this permit may be revoked by the Superior Court, after a hearing upon notice to the Applicant, if the court finds the Applicant is no longer qualified for the issuance of the permit. At any time, the county prosecutor of any county, the chief of police of any municipality, the superintendent, or any citizen may

apply to the court for the revocation of this permit, pursuant to N.J.S.A. 2C:58-4(f).
